

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS REGARDING

MCPBC, INC 2010 ELECTIONS

In response to the requests of many of our members on the MCPBC who want the election of 2010 to be conducted as soon as possible and without further delay, the Executive Committee is considering the following amendments to Article 7 of the Constitution and Bylaws. The Executive Committee will be submitting these amendments for your consideration at a later date. However, before there is a vote on the proposed amendments, the Executive Committee is seeking your comments regarding these proposed amendments. Please provide us with your comments by no later than August 11, 2010. Once we have the comments back, the Executive Committee will be submitting these proposed amendments with any required changes to a vote in later August, 2010. It is our hope that the election process can commence soon after the votes on the amendments are counted.

These proposed amendments are intended to be effective and valid only with respect to the 2010 election, and will be void after that process is completed.

PLEASE COMMENT ON THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS BELOW

WE ARE NOT SEEKING YOUR APPROVAL AT THIS TIME ONLY YOUR COMMENTS

I. Article 7, Section (2), this amendment will be added to Section (2): ö For the purpose of the 2010 election only, a request for nominations will be announced at Friday prayer and the nomination form will be posted on the MCPBC website. Within 10 days, the nomination forms must be mailed by certified mail to P.O. Box 18003, West Palm Beach, FL 33416. 7 days will then be allowed for nomination acceptance and withdrawal. The nomination forms will not be mailed to individual voters but will be available at the Mosque or at the MCPBC website.ö

II. Article 7, Section (3), this amendment will be added to Section (3): ö For the purpose of the 2010 election only, the requirement that candidates for the election to the offices of the Executive Committee shall be voting members for the MCPBC, Inc. for a minimum of two years preceding the election year, shall be waived.ö

III. Article 7, Section (6), this amendment will be added to Section (6): öFor the purpose of the 2010 election only, the election procedure, as set forth in the Constitution, will continue even if it goes through the month of Ramadan.ö

IV. Article 7, Section (8), this amendment will be added to Section (8): “For the purpose of the 2010 election only, upon the completion of the election process, the Board of Trustees responsibility as the Election Committee will end, and these members will still remain as the Board of Trustees of the MCPBC.ö

V. Article 7, this amendment will be added as a new Section (9): öFor purpose of voting in the 2010 election only, the 2009 membership rolls will be considered valid through the completion of the 2010 election.ö
